The project has been developed under Delegated oversight.

Design standards conform to the current AASHTO guidelines. The Deputy Secretary and State Transportation Engineer approved the design concepts and standards on 03/21/2017.

The Field Check was conducted on 11/21/2017.

Railroad coordination is not needed.

The Status of Project Environmental Concerns-Final was completed on 01/11/2018.

The project meets the 4(d) rule for NLEB-USFWS and written concurrence is forthcoming.

The project does not involve nor substantially impair the function of Section 4(f) lands.

The project does not involve nor substantially impair the function of Section 6(f) lands.

The project does not have a substantial negative effect on social and economic concerns.
