### **✓ Zip Code** + **4**:

This is the four-digit zip code extension available at <a href="http://zip4.usps.com/zip4/welcome.jsp">http://zip4.usps.com/zip4/welcome.jsp</a>.

#### **✓** UEI Number

The Unique Entity ID is a 12-character alphanumeric identifier used in SAM.gov and other federal government systems as a way to identify a unique entity. The UEI assignment is FREE for all businesses required to register with the US Federal government for contracts or grants. See <a href="https://sam.gov/content/entity-registration">https://sam.gov/content/entity-registration</a>.

## **✓** Parent Organization's UEI Number

Complete if applicable. This is typically used by large organizations with multiple facilities in several locations. The parent organization's number is the number assigned to the headquarters for the operation.

## **✓** Principal Place of Performance

Complete if the primary place of performance is different than the address listed above.

### **✓** Executive Compensation Information

Review the following questions to determine whether you are required to report executive compensation information.

- 1. In your preceding completed fiscal year, did your business or organization receive:
  - a. 80 percent or more of its annual gross revenues from federal procurement contracts (and subcontracts), and federal financial assistance subject to the Transparency Act, as defined in 2 CFR 170.320; and
  - b. \$25,000,000 or more in annual gross revenues from federal procurement contracts (and subcontracts), and federal financial assistance subject to the Transparency Act?

If the answer to either Question 1a or 1b is "no", your organization's compensation information is not required. <u>Do not complete</u> the Executive Compensation Information section of the FFATA Data Form.

If the answer to both 1a and 1b is "Yes", proceed to Question 2.

2. Does the public have access to the information about the compensation of the executives through periodic reports filed under section 13(a) or 15(d) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 [15 U.S.C. 78M(a), 78o(d)] or section 6104 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986? #### **Definitions**
