

**JOHNSON COUNTY WASTEWATER / CITY OF OVERLAND PARK
RIGHT-OF-WAY AGREEMENT
REFERENCE SHEET**

Background: The existing right-of-way agreement between the City and County provides a cooperative framework for managing sanitary sewer facilities, including related construction activities, within the City's right-of-way

Key Items:

- ✓ Section 9 of the Agreement highlights procedures and financial responsibilities for relocating or adjusting sanitary sewer facilities located within the City's right-of-way.
- ✓ Exhibit A of the Agreement graphically depicts criteria for determining funding responsibilities.
- ✓ **INCLUDE QUANTIFIABLE & SEPARATE LINE ITEM BIDS** for all sanitary sewer construction within the right-of-way on projects where Johnson County Wastewater funding will be pursued.
- ✓ Include a line item breakdown on payment requests to JCW.
 - What quantity or percentage is within the right-of-way?
 - What percentage of the total sanitary sewer construction costs within the right-of-way is JCW responsible for paying on the project?
