885 - RESIDENT TRANSPORTATION SERVICE

885.1 DESCRIPTION

This item includes providing residents transportation to their vehicle parked adjacent to the project due to the concrete pavement construction. The contractor shall provide transportation between the hours of 5:00 AM and 12:00 AM daily, or as specifically requested by residents outside of these hours, from the resident's home to their vehicle and back to their home by means of a golf cart or similar type of transportation. This service shall be provided for residents that cannot drive to their home due to the roadway being unable to support vehicle traffic or their driveway cutoff due to concrete pavement, driveway, or curb construction. The service is not required for the duration of the project but only for the sections of roadway where the construction prohibits resident's access to drive into their driveway due to the concrete paving, curb, or driveway construction. This service cannot be used as a substitute to "Temporary Surfacing Material."

The contractor shall maintain a phone number that residents can call to get transportation to their vehicle or home during the 5:00 AM to 12:00 AM window or as requested by the resident prior to needing transportation outside of these hours. The contractor shall keep at least one golf cart or other means of transport on the project and shall be able to pick up residents at their driveway within 15 minutes of requesting transportation. The contractor shall pick up residents as close to their front door as possible and shall not require residents to step over curb or other obstacles to get to the transportation. The golf cart or other means of transport should be covered to keep passengers dry with seating for at least the driver and two residents plus their belongings.

885.2 MEASUREMENT AND PAYMENT

Payment for "Resident Transportation Service" at the contract lump sum price bid is full compensation for the specified work and shall include all materials and labor necessary to complete the transportation service.
