1 Description

3M™ ElectroCut™ Film 1170C Clear (the "Film") is a clear, durable, transparent, UV-resistant, acrylic film coated with a transparent, pressure-sensitive adhesive that is protected by a removable liner.

The Film fulfills the clear overlaminate requirement of the 3M™ MCS™ Warranty for Traffic and 3M™ MCS™ Warranty. See the 3M Sign Warranty Bulletin and imaging method specific warranty matrix listed at the end of this document for matched component requirements and warranty details.

The Film is compatible with the following 3M reflective sheetings:

2 Specifications

If Film is applied to a compatible 3M retroreflective sheeting (as listed in Section 1) according to 3M recommendations, the resulting construction will conform to the performance requirements of ASTM D4956.

3 System of Matched Components

For a complete list of matched components approved by 3M for use with the Film covered in this bulletin and used for the creation of permanent signage, please see the 3M Sign Warranty Bulletin.

4 Shelf Life

Store in a cool, dry area at 65°F to 75°F (18°C to 24°C) and a relative humidity of 30-50%. Film must be applied to the substrate within two years of the date of manufacture.

5 Handling and Application Procedures

Note: Read the manufacturer's operating manual carefully and follow all prescribed procedures when using any equipment.

- 1 Avoid flexing the Film excessively when handling it. Flexing the Film may cause it to release from the liner.
- 2 The Film may be applied to sheeting either before or after the sheeting has been applied to the substrate. Follow all 3M lamination recommendations.
- 3 Excess or overhanging Film should be trimmed using a clean, sharp utility knife held at an angle of 30° relative to the substrate. Remove adhesive build-up using a soft cloth dampened with mineral spirits, isopropyl alcohol, or 3M Citrus Base Cleaner.

Note: 3M does NOT recommend splicing the Film.

6 Durability

Please refer to <u>3M Information Folder 1.7</u>. Periodic Sign inspection and regular Sign replacement are strongly recommended in order to help Sign owners establish their own effective service life expectations, beyond the warranty period.
